Enable a School Wide Improvement Agenda to ensure:

- Expert staff capability to implement the school wide improvement agenda
- All students are supported to achieve above National Minimum Standards (NMS) and at a C/Sound standard
- A 10% increase across the school in the number of students demonstrating high levels of academic achievement (U2B and B/High or A/Very High) in Reading, Writing and Numeracy

Our initiatives include

Implementing a capacity building strategy, including

- Provide ongoing opportunities for all teachers and teacher aides to engage in individualised, targeted strategies focused on achieving expert capacity to implement high impact, data informed pedagogy, differentiated curriculum expectations and school wide pedagogy expectations (Gradual Release of Responsibility, Explicit Instruction and Student Goal and Feedback Cycles) in Reading, Writing and Number;
- Establishing collaborative Curriculum Coordination Time through the Specialist Timetable focussing on Curriculum Intent, Data Informed planning and expert pedagogy

Targeted intervention programs for students from Prep to Year 6

School wide Specialist Science Program

Network / ICT Support and Integrated online communications including Facebook, SMS, QSchools, QParents and School Website

Literacy support programs for Prep (Race into Reading and Race into Writing)

Providing online resources including Mathletics, Reading Eggs, Spelling City and Sound Waves to engage students at school and at home.


Our school will improve student outcomes by

Combining 2017 funds with \$116 663.00 carried forward from 2016 to:

- Implement a capacity building strategy through targeted Curriculum Coordination time through an additional 1.4 FTE to establish a Specialist Science program (\$108 000.00)
- Provide additional Teacher Aide time for Prep, Intervention and ICT/Network support (\$128 000.00)
- Provide access to targeted professional development for teaching staff (\$29 739.00)
- Online resources subscription fees (\$20 000.00)
