This funding will be used to

Enable a School Wide Improvement Agenda to ensure:

- Expert staff capability to implement the school wide improvement agenda
- All students are supported to achieve above National Minimum Standards (NMS) and at a C/Sound standard including students on ICPs
- A 10% increase across the school in the number of students demonstrating high levels of academic achievement (U2B and B/High or A/Very High) in Reading, Writing and Numeracy

Our initiatives include

1. Implementing a capacity building strategy, including:
 - Provide ongoing opportunities for all teachers and teacher aides to engage in individualised, targeted strategies focused on achieving expert capacity to implement high impact, data informed pedagogy, differentiated curriculum expectations and school wide pedagogy expectations (Literacy Continuum, Learning Walls, Gradual Release of Responsibility and Student Goal and Feedback Cycles) in Reading, Writing and Number. Strategies include:
 - Targeted Professional Development
 - Coaching and feedback for all staff through Collaborative Curriculum Time (CCT)
2. Provide targeted intervention programs for students from Prep to Year 6
3. Continue school wide specialist Science program
4. Providing full time teacher Aides in Prep
5. Providing online resources including Mathletics, Reading Eggs, Spelling City and Sound Waves to engage students at school and at home.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Continue to implement a capacity building strategy through targeted Curriculum Coordination time through an additional 1 FTE to maintain a Specialist Science program (\$89 000.00)
- Implement targeted intervention and extension programs across Prep to Year 6 through an additional 0.5 FTE (\$44 500.00)
- Provide additional Teacher Aide time for targeted literacy support programs and full time teacher aides for Prep support (\$45 023.00)
